E.g. I tripped up on the paving leg and broke my stone.

Answer: leg and stone should be swapped round.

<u>Type 2:</u> In the sentences below underline one of the words in the brackets that fits in with the rest of the sentence:-

E.g. The old lady had a home help who (arrested, assisted, agitated) her.

Answer: assisted

<u>Type 3:</u> In the following sentences are two words that sound the same, but which are spelt differently. Underline the word that you think is correct for the sentence.

E.g. We had a lovely walk along the (peer, pier).

Answer: pier

<u>Type 4</u>: In each line below, rearrange the words so that they are in alphabetical order and then underline the word that would be <u>third</u> in the new order:-

E.g. water warden walrus wander waist

Answer: wander (1 - waist, 2 - walrus, 3 - wander, 4 - warden, 5 - water)
