<u>Type 1:</u>

From the information given below, work out which <u>one</u> of the four sentences a, b, c or d will be the correct sentence for the statement below.

Eg) Henry VIII had six wives but only one son.

- a) Henry VIII had two daughters.
- b) Henry VIII divorced two of his wives.
- c) Henry VIII was the father of a son.
- d) Two of his wives were beheaded.

Answer: c

Type 2:

Below are sequences of letters which have some gaps in them. Work out what letters are missing in the sequence and then fill in the gaps.

A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z

Answer: EV FU - 1st letter in each pair moves forwards; second letter moves backwards

<u>Type 3:</u>

In the lines below, choose one word from each group of three words, so that when the two words are put together they will make a longer word. Underline the two words.

Answer: "under" and "stand" make the word "understand"

<u>Type 4:</u>

In the following questions work out the answers to the sums using the letters provided. Make sure you write the answer AS A LETTER.

$$A = 1$$
, $B = 2$, $C = 4$, $D = 5$, $E = 10$.

$$Eg) \qquad C + D + A = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$$

Answer: E (4 + 5 + 1 = 10 and 10 = E)
